WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY CARE ASSOCIATION?

The Association is a registered charity (number 1178776) which is managed by a Board of Trustees who are all volunteers. The committee meets regularly and welcomes new members.

The Centre is based in Town Close in Stokesley and offers facilities for a variety of social and support groups. There is a staff team of nine coordinating the day to day running of the Centre. There are two large Activity Rooms and a Meeting Room for hire. We have disabled facilities and can provide refreshments.

Our aim is to identify needs and support the local community. We cover Stokesley, Great Ayton, Great Broughton, Hutton Rudby and all the villages within a 15 mile radius of Stokesley.

Our volunteers offer vital support and services in a range of activities which are detailed overleaf. We are always looking for new volunteers to join our team. If you are interested please do not hesitate to contact us

SERVICES WE PROVIDE

Rural Community Transport—Provided by two fully accessible Mini Buses and a Volunteer Car Scheme.

We provide a door to door service for elderly and disabled clients. Just ring the office with as much notice as possible to book your transport. This could be for hospital / doctor / dentist appointments. We also run monthly excursions and shopping trips. Tel: 01642 710085/710190

Respite Sitting Scheme - A volunteer sitter gives regular carers a much needed break of up to 2 hours per week in the client's own home.

Befriending Scheme – A service for the lonely & housebound. A volunteer will visit on a regular basis to sit and chat or do light shopping or pick up a prescription.

Day Centre – Our Day Centre is for people with dementia. We operate on Mondays & Wednesdays each week from 10am – 3pm. The Centre is run by qualified paid staff and supported by volunteers.

Carers Group – Every second Friday at CCA meeting room 10-12pm. Join people for friendly discussion, advice and talks on matters relating to care. Run by Carers Plus Yorkshire

Lunch Club – Run every Thursday from 12 noon at the Town Hall. A hot lunch and dessert with tea or coffee to finish. Ring the office to book a place.

Chair aerobics – at the Town Hall from 10.30 to 11.30am, every Thursday. Exercise to music while seated & make new friends as well.

Tea Dances – Held at WI Hall, Great Ayton alternate Thursday afternoons 1.30 – 3.30pm. this includes light refreshments. Please ring the office for dates.

Pensioners Meet:- Held fortnightly on a Monday at Stokesley Sports Social Club 12-2pm. Social afternoon for the elderly with bingo, quiz, games and light lunch – Carers and family members also welcome.
